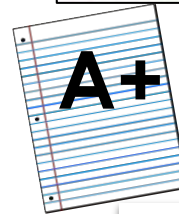

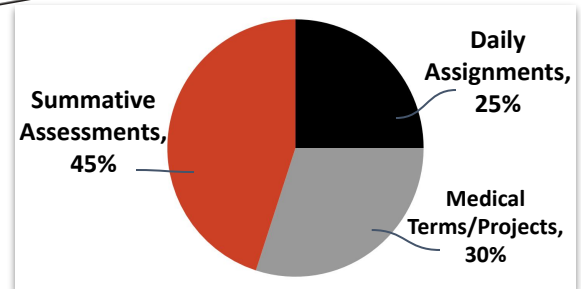

Grading Policy:

Late Work Policy:

The same course grade assigned to the Essentials of Healthcare will be assigned to the Human Anatomy and Physiology course.
