DISTRICT GOALS

- Increase literacy rates— By the end of the 21-22 school year, increase the overall percentage of students moving from one performance band on local district assessments and universal screening data by 3%.
- FAST bridge (aReading-group screening report) should show 80% of K-2 students performing in the average to above average range in the Spring administration
- Decrease the percentage of ISS referrals by 3% at each school and the percentage of OSS referrals by 5% for the 2020-21 school year as compared to the 2019-20 office referrals (ECD/males for K-12)
- Increase CCRPI scores and student performance on all local district assessments

LEE COUNTY PRIMARY SCHOOL GOALS:

- To decrease the percentage by 3% of students being retained, with a specific focus on economically disadvantaged students.
- Reduce percentage of students scoring at level I in ELA Priority Standards by 3%.
- Increase percentage by 3% of students scoring in the exceeds level in place value, comparison and addition and subtraction on the LCSS standards-based report card.
- Reduce the number of ODR's by 3% based upon 2020-21 year end data.

JOINTLY DEVELOPED

The parents, students, and staff of Lee County Primary School partnered together to develop this school-parent compact for achievement.
