

Lee County School System K-5 Plan for Reopening 2020-2021

Masks / Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)



- Masks are highly encouraged
- Additional PPE in clinics when serving medically fragile students
- Students with a temperature at or above 100.4 F will be isolated in a monitored room in order to be sent home. Mask will be required in the monitored isolation room
- Masks/shields should be washed daily if reusable
- Mask design should be school appropriate

Enhanced Cleaning



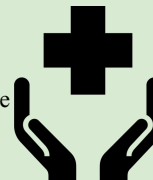
- Improved routine cleaning and disinfecting of facilities throughout the day by custodians
- Safe and effective cleaner provided to all teachers and staff to use in high touch services throughout the day

Wellness / Hygiene



- Students will face in the same direction while seated
- Space desks/tables apart as much as possible
 - Hand washing breaks throughout the day
 - Students will be asked to wash hands for 20 seconds with antibacterial soap
 - Small group area will be sanitized in between groups
 - Liquid hand sanitizer will be available throughout the building
 - Water fountains will be turned off. Water bottles encouraged for hydrating throughout the day (please label with your child's name)
 - Temperature checks will be taken before entering the building
 - CDC-designed signage displayed prominently throughout buildings to reinforce healthy hygiene and expected school behaviors
 - All attendance incentives will be put on hold including perfect attendance awards
 - Students should not share supplies when possible
 - Students should respect others personal space

Health Services



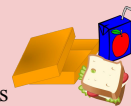
- All persons that are sick will be expected to stay home
- Those who become sick at school will be sent home immediately
- Students reporting to the clinic will have their temperature checked
- A monitored isolation room will house any symptomatic person

School Logistics



- No programs/assemblies at this time (No in-person recognition at this time, i.e. Model Student, Open House)
- School personnel will provide daily announcements to reinforce procedures and safety precautions
- No visitors at this time
- Daily schedule will be adjusted to reduce the number of students in the hallway.

Student Meals



- Initially, student meals will be consumed in the classroom
- When the cafeteria is used, students will be spaced out facing one direction
- Additional picnic tables have been purchased to have students sit outside, weather permitting
- Students will use their IDs to have touchless interaction at the point of sale
- Online payment is encouraged

Recess / PE Art / Music



- Students will go outside, weather permitting for recess
- Initially, PE classes will be outside. If weather does not permit, they will be placed into smaller groups in the building
- Initially, Art and Music teachers will come into homerooms

K-2 School Procedures

Car Riders



DROP OFF-

-Parents may walk their **Kindergarten** student to a designated exterior door on the **first day of school only**.

-1st and 2nd grade students will need to go through the car drop off line unless they have a Kindergarten sibling.

- After the 1st day of school, **no walk ups will be allowed during drop off**. All students will be required to go through the car drop off line. Parents need to remain in their vehicle.

PICK UP

- **Parents will not be allowed to walk up to the building to get their child at dismissal**. All parents must go through the car pick up line to pick their child up after school.

Technology/Media



- Computers will be sanitized between student use
- Books will be sanitized between use



Restrooms



- Improved routine cleaning and disinfecting of facilities throughout the day by custodians
- Limit to 4 at a time in hallway restrooms
- Antibacterial soap has been purchased
- Encourage hand washing not hanging out in the bathroom

Transitions



- Teachers make transitions instead of students if at all possible
- Transitions will be limited to only necessary movements in the building.

Social Emotional



- Counselors have been given information on weekly talks (webinars) to assist with helping students when they return to traditional school
