Discussion was held regarding the potential SPLOST projects.

Dr. Miller provided a Board compensation comparison for systems within the Southwest GA RESA network. One of the documents he provided to the Board reflected Board compensation has not changed since 1992. Dr. Miller would like the Board to consider increasing the Board compensation rate of pay. He said it would need Board approve and legislative change. Frank Griffin thanked Dr. Miller for bringing this to their attention but stated he does not see a need to increase the rate of pay.
