Mr. Hatcher discussed personnel needs generally with respect to extracurricular activities. He expressed that our Board believes all aspects of a child's education are important, including the classroom, extra-curricular activities, job experience and training, and other of life's situations that present opportunities to be well-rounded and learn valuable life skills. He noted that this time each year we are placed in the difficult position of finding enough suitable staff vacancies to fill our extra-curricular needs, and that problem is exacerbated by staff who come into our system to coach or sponsor, gain tenure, and then unilaterally determine they will no longer coach or sponsor. Mr. Hatcher said the Board needs to inquire into whether tenure is more

beneficial to our school system than it is detrimental, and if it is not, should consider asking the state for a waiver of the tenure provisions. Mr. Hatcher invited open discussion on the issue from any interested stakeholders. Board Chair, Frank Griffin, agreed with Mr. Hatcher's remarks.

On motion by Sylvia Vann, second by Bob Usry, the Board unanimously approved the 2017-2018 handbooks for Pre-K, LCES and TOES.

On motion by Claire Lang, second by Louis Hatcher, the Board unanimously approved providing a bus and driver during the summer months to transport children on field trips for YMCA Summer Day Camp at the rate of \$10.00 per hour for driver and \$2.00 per mile for bus.

On motion by Louis Hatcher to review an appeal from a Student Disciplinary Tribunal and to consult and meet with legal counsel pertaining to pending or potential litigation, settlement, claims, administrative proceedings, or other judicial actions brought or to be brought by or against the school district or an officer or employee or in which the officer or employee may be directly involved, second by Bob Usry, the Board unanimously approved to enter executive session. Board Members voting to enter executive session were Frank Griffin, Louis Hatcher, Claire Lang, Bob Usry and Sylvia Vann.
