Topics of discussion included:

- Sylvia Vann- Goals: Mrs. Vann provided copies of previously adopted goals and asked others if they had any goals they would like to add or remove.
- School System Web Page- Modernize the webpage; check other school systems to find sites that are appealing; advertising on site was discussed.
- LCHS Exam exemptions- survey to see what other systems are doing: Is there a valid reason to take exam? Are students being challenged?
- GLISI- Balanced Scorecard: only heard good things, user friendly, school system must make commitment.
- Course Rigor- Are students being challenged?; What type of “product” are we producing?; We should improve overall SAT score!
- Student/Teacher Achievement- would like to see murals at high school; spotlight student/teacher at each board meeting; showcase student/teacher achievement on website.
- Community Survey- parent satisfaction survey; share results on-line.
- State Department of Education Standards Task Force- GSBA standards are being used as a guide in rewriting the standards.
- Facilities/Programs- remodeling high school bandroom; add Computer Science program; high school person to work with students and parents to secure college scholarships and track students after high school; look closely at data? Are we doing all we can to prepare students?
