The public hearing of the Lee County Board of Education was called to order by Chairperson Frank Griffin. Frank Griffin provided the invocation. The other members present were Louis Hatcher, Bob Usry and Sylvia Vann.

The public hearing was held to provide an opportunity for public input regarding the school system's proposed budget.

Gary Kelley provided a page by page presentation of the anticipated changes. Notable changes are: reduction in class size grades K-5, Literacy Coordinator for grades K-5, dual enrollment counselor, two middle school instructional specialists, technology upgrades related to security and personnel related to school safety is allocated in the proposed budget. The budget presented in June has a few changes from the budget presented in April. The result of these changes will increase the estimated tax increase from 1.2 mills to 1.8 mills in total. 1.2 M&O and .6 Bond

Bob Usry asked questions regarding specific details of the proposed budget.

No comments or questions from the audience.

On motion by Louis Hatcher to review an appeal from a Student Disciplinary Tribunal, second by Bob Usry the Board unanimously approved to enter executive session. Board Members voting to enter executive session were Frank Griffin, Louis Hatcher, Sylvia Vann and Bob Usry.

On motion by Louis Hatcher, second by Sylvia Vann, the Board unanimously voted to re-open the meeting.

On motion by Bob Usry, second by Louis Hatcher, the Board unanimously voted to uphold the decision of tribunal appeal in the case of A.H.

On motion by Louis Hatcher, second by Bob Usry, the meeting was adjourned.
