On motion by Louis Hatcher, second by Claire Lang, the Board voted 4-1 to partner with Lee County Board of Commissioners up to \$30,000 on the Traylor Business Services, Inc contract. Traylor Business Services, Inc. will perform personal property verification reviews of Lee County's business taxpayers. Bob Usry opposed.

On motion by Louis Hatcher, second by Claire Lang, the Board unanimously approved a request to change financing agreement on Georgia Power Investment Grade Audit from TCF Equipment to City National Capital Finance. City National Capital Finance provided a better interest rate (4.29%) for 15 years.

On motion by Sylvia Vann, second by Louis Hatcher, the Board voted 4-1 to approve the FY 19 budget. Bob Usry opposed. Mr. Usry stated he is not anti-education or anti-security but he has received several calls from large land owners and he stated the increase will hurt them.

On motion by Louis Hatcher, second by Sylvia Vann, the meeting was adjourned.
