The public hearing of the Lee County Board of Education was called to order by Chairperson Frank Griffin. Frank Griffin provided the invocation. The other members present were Louis Hatcher, Bob Usry and Sylvia Vann.

The public hearing was held to provide an opportunity for public input regarding the school system's proposed budget.

Gary Kelley provided a page by page presentation of the anticipated changes. Notable changes are: reduction in class size grades K-5, Literacy Coordinator for grades K-5, dual enrollment counselor at LCHS, two middle school instructional specialists, technology upgrades related to security and personnel related to school safety are allocated in the proposed budget. The budget presented in June has a few changes from the budget presented in April. The result of these changes the estimated tax increase 1.8 mills in total. 1.2 M&O and .6 Bond

Bob Usry asked a few questions regarding the proposed budget.

Frank Griffin and Claire Lang provided a few comments on the proposed budget.

No comments or questions from the audience.
