If they choose to use a school copy, books must be returned to the school with no markings on the pages. Failure to abide by this policy may result in the student/parent receiving a bill for the cost of replacing the book. Students are welcome to use their own Kindle or other digital reader, but again, they may benefit from being able to write in their own paper copy.
