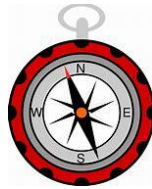

**PBIS**

PBIS is Positive Behavior Supports and Interventions. Each month we will recognize a teacher and staff member that exhibits the use of PBIS. We will also focus as a school on an intervention to improve our school discipline.

Has your child mentioned his or her lanyard? Students and staff are wearing lanyards for safety and to earn positive behavior points. Students also use the ID to check out library books. Students that are displaying one of our STAR expectations (see above) earns points. These points can be exchanged monthly in the STARBUCKS Store.
